

EMOTIONAL TOUR OF CAMPANIA

Day 1: NAPLES

Arrival at airport of Naples and bus transfer to city of Naples. Guided tour of the Museum and of the Certosa of San Martino. Among the sections of the museum, the room of the carriages, the gardens and the Christmas Crèches (Presepi) section. The rooms are decorated with frescoes of paintings of the XVII - XVIII century. Hotel accommodation in Naples, dinner and overnight.

Day 2: NAPLES CENTRAL AND GOTHIC (DECUMANI AREA)

Breakfast and visit of the city center of Naples. It will be possible stroll in the famous via Toledo and Spaccanapoli, the famous road that divides the city in two parts. The visit continues in San Gregorio Armeno road, the picturesque road of crèches, San Lorenzo Maggiore and Via Duomo with the great cathedral with its magnificent baptistery, the Early Christian Basilica and the Chapel that houses the relics of San Gennaro and the two ampoules containing his blood that melts twice every year. You will continue to Maschio Angioino, the castle was built in the '200 for the Anjou, it has five cylindrical towers and the Arc de Triomphe, then to the San Carlo Theatre, built in 1737 by Carlo di Borbone, it is among the oldest and beautiful Theatre in Europe. Continuing to Galleria Umberto I, elegant commercial passage of the '800, then Piazza Plebiscito, the seventeenth-century Palazzo Reale, the residence of the Borbone and the famous Castel dell'Ovo, legend says that there is an egg hidden in the secrets: if it breaks, the fortress could collapse and Naples undergo a series of disasters. Free lunch, dinner and overnight.

Day 3: VESUVIAN VILLAS - RAILWAY MUSEMUM OF Pietrarsa

Breakfast and bus trasfer to visit some Vesuvian Villas, built for the summer stay of the noble families, in particular, you can see Villa Ginestre in Torre del Greco known especially because the poet Giacomo Leopardi spent there the last season of his life, and he composed some of his poems including the famous "La Ginestra", which later took the name of the villa. Bus Transfer to Villa Campolieto, in Ercolano, creation of the architect Vanvitelli, the floor plan is rectangular, with a central dome illuminated by four oval windows. Bus Transfer to the Railway Museum of Pietrarsa, one of the most important centers of industrial architecture, really interesting is the absolute affinity between the history of its architecture and history that it tell. Free lunch, dinner and overnight.

Day 4 ARCHAEOLOGICAL POMPEI / ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM AND VIRTUAL

Breakfast and bus transfer to visit of the famous ruins of Pompeii, the ancient city was buried under dust and lapillus during the eruption of Vesuvius in 79, with Ercolano, Stabiae and Oplontis. The findings following the excavations, are among the best examples of Roman life helpful to understand the uses, customs, eating habits and the way of life of more than two millennia ago. In 1997, to preserve the integrity and emphasize its importance, the ruins, have become part of the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Bus Transfer to the Mav (Archaeological and Virtual Museum), a dive into the past through a multisensory experience to discover the historical realities of Pompeii and Ercolano before the eruption of Vesuvius in 79. Free lunch, dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 PANORAMIC TOUR OF THE ISLAND OF ISCHIA - CASTLE ARAGONESE + COMMON ISLAND

Breakfast and bus transfer to port of Naples. Ferry transfers to Ischia, the largest island of the Gulf of Naples, it is home of one of the active volcanoes in Italy, Monte Epomeo, today the island is famous for the magnificent Aragonese Castle, the islet on which was built the castle comes from an eruption occurred 300,000 years ago. Geologically it is a bubble of magma that was consolidated during eruptions. Today it is possible to enter into the castle through a tunnel dug into the rock and took in the mid-fifteenth century by Alfonso V of Aragon, before that access was possible only by sea via stair located on the north side of the islet. local bus Transfer to visit some of the towns on the island (ex. Casamicciola, the famous for the thermal baths, Lacco Ameno, famous for the Archaeological Museum of Pithecusae which houses artifacts including the famous Nestor's Cup), Ischia was In fact, the first settlement in greek in Tyrrhenian area). Free lunch, Ferry trasfer to the porto of Naples. Bus trasfer to the hotel in Naples, dinner and overnight.

DAY 6 - COAST (AMALFI - POSITANO)

Breakfast and bus transfer to Salerno and ferry transfer to Amalfi, a place that gives its name to the coast, nestled between mountains and sea, city with a glorious history, was the main of the Maritime Republics. Symbol of Amalfi is the Duomo, also interesting is the Museum which houses the Tabula Amalphitana. Ferry Transfer to Positano, a resort frequented since Roman times. The city is built on several floors, connected by a lot of stairs. Interesting is the church of Santa Maria Assunta and the beautiful historic center full of shops and boutiques of the famous fashion Positano. Free lunch. Ferry transfer to Salerno and bus trasfer to return to the hotel in Naples, dinner and overnight.

Day 7 - Breakfast and bus transfer to the Naples airport. End of services.
